We are grateful for what we have seen the Lord doing through our station. Our national pastor was visiting in the hospital recently when a lady came up to him and told him that she listens to him on our radio station every day. Recently she had come under conviction and gave her heart to the Lord. We don't know how many times this has happened but we continually hear of our listeners being brought to the Lord through the broadcasts.

I had the unfortunate experience of landing in the local hospital myself in March. I came down with pneumonia. Since I am out of remission with my leukemia the doctor didn't want me staying in the hospital any longer than necessary so he sent me home and put me on antibiotics. The testing in the hospital revealed that I have some other medical issues that I didn't know about so I am being sent back to Manila soon.

Ruth Ann has finished another school year. She was honored this year with the yearbook being dedicated to her. Please pray for Ruth Ann as she is due for a check-up from her cancer tumor removal so she will be going with me. Pray that she will get a good report and that I can get back into remission.

Fortunately, we have a young man, Nathan Fry, who is here for the summer and he will be running the station while we are away. We just pray that there will be no technical problems. The Lord has been good and we have been rather trouble free for many months now. Most of the issues are computer related since the station programming runs with an automation program.

Recently a group of men from the Department of Education came by the station and told us they can hear our stations loud and clear on their home islands of Pingelap, Kapingamarangi, and Nukuoro which are the islands farthest away from us. We are the only radio station they can hear. We praise the Lord for this!
