*February begins our fifth year in service together with you for Christ and His Kingdom. We see how important it is to post prayer requests and insight into the work God has called us to. It is good for us too that our communication with you is current and necessary. Although I am behind in getting it out; It may be a little lengthy, there is more to tell.*

*Countless hours of prayer enter God's throne of grace. There peace reigns and praises flow in God's response to our need; there is help. Today, as I finish this letter my heart is pounding. Yesterday Marc, who I have mentioned for prayer countless times, tried to take his own life. If you recall, he was a student of LMCS my first two years. His family is mormon and withdrew him. I knew that God was doing something when I received a phone call asking me to help him with problems he was having in the other school. We have been meeting regularly in my home and he loves it when we sit and open the Bible. We have been praying for God to save him and his household. Last night's events may be what it takes for the gospel to become real to them. Marc's life was spared. I want this notice to cause you to pray urgently for each of my students with the same fervency. "Life is but a vapor" says James, and Jesus insists the night is coming. David sings in anticipation, "weeping may endure for a night but Joy cometh in the morning!"*

**Thank God for His Provisions:** While LMCS provides the airfare and we take the short furloughs at the schools request; ground transportation and accommodations are a huge burden to visit the churches and supporters each time we return to the States. **We are very grateful to a family in Greenville SC who gave us the full use of a Honda Odyssey. They are also the ones who donated the money for our vehicle purchase last year.** During the seven week period we had the privilege to report to eleven churches. Staying in prophets chambers or treated to splendid hotel accommodations, we subsisted on love offerings and were showered with meals and a time to recharge our batteries. We traveled nearly ten thousand miles problem free and under God's staying hand with health, safety driving in winter conditions, and openings of additional services for Chapel and two missions conferences. We are fully blessed and energized for the remainder of the year. We have had several individuals both in Peru and stateside interested in helping the deaf family in Antioquia. One gave a PocketTalker hearing device; Another a whole years-worth of hearing aid batteries. We picked up more Spanish materials for class. Upon reporting to a church in Burlington NC, the congregation voted to donate a complete communion set plus an additional spare tray, which we passed on to a congregation in Puerto Mondalado.
