Following the doctor's advice, we saw a specialist and had a biopsy done on the left breast. This test was positive as 3rd grade of cancer. We were advised to have it removed immediately. For her age of 74, she has been very strong and healthy these many years. She was very unhappy to have to go through the surgery. She also had high blood pressure. The operation was scheduled for the 22nd of October, but due to her blood pressure, it was postponed to the 2nd of November 2012. The surgery was successful by God's grace. Some of the lymph nodes were enlarged. Now, Molly will have to undergo 9 weeks of chemo therapy, as well as 9 weeks of radiation and Harmon therapy. We are shocked by the emotional and financial strain this will cause. We appreciate your continued prayer throughout this situation.

Our children, Leena, Francis, Abigail, Charles, Emma, Adrian, and our grandchildren came to our help in every way. They were strained to the limit, but lovingly helped us. Molly and I thank God for our family. Richard and Leah kept inquiring from California. Richard even made a visit to the hospital in Bangalore while on his tour to North East Asia. Steve & his family also made a visit to Bangalore, stayed almost 2 weeks, and helped by way of medical advice. Lemuel and Marcy, being much concerned, also helped us in many ways. Churches in India and around the world have prayed for us. What an international family we have!

The work and ministry has been continuing. We praise God that in our absence of 5 months, the Lord has been very faithful to His people. We thank Him for all He is doing in our midst. The enemy, of course, has been more active now than ever, especially in these evil days. We are still facing difficulties with the school recognition. The power (electricity) situation is not any better. We are not able to contact most of you on the Internet except through our Mission Board, due to these problems.

Many of you have sent us cards, letters, and greetings. Thank you so much for remembering us. We appreciate your love & concern. Thank you again for your understanding. May the Lord help and encourage our hearts as we keep looking unto him. We love you all.
