Times are very hard economically in the lower islands and these dear folk are looking for opportunities to help their children with college. Our job is to intercept them and make sure they get in Church. So many get lost in the crowd.
3. One of our Kosraen ladies recently had a kidney transplant, but her body rejected it. Please pray for her. She is very discouraged. Her Husband donated the rejected kidney.
4. We have another Kosraen lady on the waiting list for a kidney transplant. Her Husband came in last night to be with her during the surgery. Please pray that this transplant will be a success.
5. We have a couple of ladies attending our services that are close to making a decision for Christ. Last week a Micronesian fellow, who is a JW, attended the regular services at Ohana Baptist. Do pray that The Word will bring him to a saving knowledge of Christ.
6. Our Micronesian Choir is singing once a month in the main English Services at Ohana Baptist Church. The English speaking folk love the Micronesian singing.
