The past three months have been rewarding and trying. In April, we were able to preach Easter weekend at Island Road Baptist Church, near Harkers Island for Pastor Charles Tyler. This is a small church, but they very active in giving to missions! In the middle of April, due to Norma's health, we had to cancel a meeting in Winston Salem.

In May, I was in a pastor's fellowship in Havelock, and I enjoyed the time and contact with Preacher Brethern from across Eastern N.C. We attended the memorial service for Bro. Paul Johnston, a former office manager for WWNTBM. He was pastoring at the time of his home going. I had the privilege of preaching in chapel at Calvary Christian Academy in New Bern, NC. Then, we finished the month with a service at Gospel Outreach Baptist Church in Perfection, NC. The first of May, I learned from a cornea specialist that I needed the top layer of my cornea removed. He said the problem was due to my many years in the Tropics. The surgery was scheduled for June 23rd.

In June, we were not able to attend our mission Family Fellowship Week in Greensboro due to Norma's health and the clinical preparation for my cornea surgery. I did close out the Faith Promise Conference for my home church in Kinston, NC before the surgery. The surgery went well, but it heals slowly as the top corneal cells begin growing back. Dr. Ouane told me it would take 3 to 6 months to regain my sight completely.

Brethren, please pray for us and the work in which are involved. Pray for the Eibens in Pohnpei with the Radio ministry. Pray for the work that we started in Pohnpei. The Capital Hill Baptist Church had one of their Sunday School & Youth buildings blown down during a recent storm. They need funds to rebuild the building and funds to get a used van for the church.
