After arriving in California, we set right to work on the projects at hand. We painted, stained, hung and finished sheetrock, cleaned, put up shelves, did some electrical work, and various other things. We were also able to work on a few of the new cabins being constructed at Camp Ironwood. There are about 8 new cabins being built as well as the Institute of Ministry building there at the Camp. We renewed some old friendships and made new friends. Please pray for Faith Baptist Church of Cherokee Road to grow and continue to reach the Newberry Springs area.

We were in two meetings in the San Francisco area. These are both small churches. This part of our country is especially cold to the gospel. The people are bound up in making money and don't have time for the Lord. Both pastors say that it is very hard to get people to see their need of salvation. They think if they are good providers for their families, they are OK. Please pray for Calvary Baptist Church and for Lighthouse Baptist Church.
