In August, we asked you to pray for our Filipino friend, Jun, that he might get his student visa and be able to attend a Bible Institute on Guam. After we received a notice from FSM Immigration that Jun had overstayed his time in the FSM, the papers arrived that allowed the U. S. Embassy to issue the visa and June is now in school on Guam. Pray for him. He wants to serve the Lord in the Philippines.

A few weeks ago our national pastor, Isamo Welles, went to the clinic. There were many people waiting, and when Pastor Welles' name was called, an elderly man approached him. He said that he lives on the back side of the island and listens to him preach every day on the radio. He expressed gratitude and appreciation for the program and for this opportunity to meet him in person.

A policeman came to the station recently asking if I had a battery for his walkie talkie. I took care of this need, and he asked if he could have a tract from our tract rack. Then he asked me what salvation means. I took the Bible and gave him the complete plan of salvation. He didn't make a decision for Christ then but indicated that he would come to our church. Please pray for this policeman.

A few weeks ago, I went over to Kosrae and preached in our Baptist Church there. Due to problems in the church it has gone from nearly 100 down to about ten. There were 15 when I preached. There is a graduate of Harvest Baptist Bible Institute trying to rebuild. He is working full time which takes away from his time for the church, and he has no transportation to bring in people. Another missionary used to bring in 25 weekly on his truck. This man needs help and if you would be interested in helping to buy a truck or give monthly support, please contact me. I did a little work for the government radio station while there and they have designated one hour each Sunday for our church to use. I have already sent over some programs we use here, and the pastor will produce a program with the equipment I have just sent. We request your prayers that this church grow and be used of the Lord.
