Dear Friends,

This week I had another visit with my Oncologist here in Greenville, SC. My blood tests showed again that my health is back to normal. There is no sign of Leukemia in my body now and the routine six month bone marrow test will not be necessary.

We have been having meetings in our supporting churches since January. In April we started going up north for meetings and will continue there for the summer. We have been presenting the need to replace our 35 year old AM transmitter on Pohnpei. The response has been great and we now have ordered and shipped the transmitter to Pohnpei. I plan to go out for the month of August to install it. Now that we have the transmitter paid for, I want to go ahead with new audio processing equipment and a modulation monitor so we can get the full capabilities from the new transmitter.

On May 22 we will be going to Marietta Bible College in Ohio to see our friends Tony and Mel Lim graduate. They will be staying on another year for seminary and will be seeking the Lord's will for their lives and service. Tony and Mel worked on Pohnpei for several years, and Mel was a volunteer worker at our station.

Nathan and Jinny McElheny and daughters Amber and Amanda continue to work at the station, church and school on Pohnpei. Please pray for them as they have been experiencing some sickness.

Our missionaries on the island of Yap, which is another state in the Federated States of Micronesia, have come to the place in their ministry where they feel a radio station would be a help with their overall work. They have acquired a tower left behind by the United States when the Trust Territory became an independent nation. We have been in discussions about building a station and feel that now is the time to get on with the project. Some money has already been raised and as soon as there is enough we will proceed with the construction. The Yap church already has adequate land at their church for putting up the tower. It is our desire that soon after completing our furlough we will be able to go over to Yap and assist with getting this station started. This will involve not only the construction of the station but taking some time to work with the new staff in operating the station. Since this is another state in our county we will be working with them in reporting news and other events which will affect both of our states. Please pray with us about this new project as it will be a great aid in helping to build the two churches we now have on Yap and even pave the way for another church in the future.
