Our summer is just about over as our school started the second week of August. During the summer, we assisted in Vacation Bible School in one of our village churches and had as many as 60 attend in one day. Five children accepted the Lord as their Savior. Our six Baptist churches had a combined teenage camp. We helped with this and were pleased to see many of them make commitments to the Lord and several were saved.

Recently, my low immunity, due to my leukemia, caused bouts with shingles and cellulitis. Thankfully, most are nearly cleared up, but it shows how vulnerable I am to viruses and infections.

We are keeping our radio station running 24 hours a day on both AM and FM, and we hear of good results. Our solar panels and wind generator keep us on the air during the many power outages and sometimes allows us to be the only station on the air during an outage. This gives us an increased audience for the Gospel.

Our replacements, the Eibens, are busy on deputation, and now have nearly half of their support. Please pray that the remainder will come in soon. We need them here so we will have time to train them before we leave the island.

I asked one of the preachers from a village what he used for preparing sermons, and he said "The two books you gave me a few years ago." That was Wiersbe's "Be" Series. This reminded me again of the need for helping these preachers get commentaries. I have been giving away some of mine to them, but there is still a great need.
