It was time for a new letter. Ann and I have not stopped long enough to sit down and put one out. The Lord has blessed in so many ways these last few months. Many calls for work and even a couple of calls on new support have been such a huge blessing to us. The need is still huge on adding support; we still have not really taken time for deputation. The work load continues to be very steady. I am not one to sit, if there is a need for help, we go. The going is not the problem; it's the getting there that is the problem. To deliver us, our tools and equipment to a church for work takes money. Last month our support check after tithes, faith promise and taxes we had 800 dollars. Half of that went for fuel for the car and the truck. The rest paid bills. We are very careful on how we spend the money that we know some give sacrificially. You will never see me wearing expensive clothes nor Ann with great big diamond rings.

As this letter goes out there has become a need for some extra financial help. Most of you know of our machine shop equipment at Mission Aero Service in New Bern, NC. We have been given a great opportunity to relocate this equipment to a new permanent location. Il Villaggio Homes in Bradenton, Fl. has given us a place to sit this equipment up in their maintenance department. The space will need some work to make it ready for us to occupy. New lighting, electrical upgrades and some cabinet work will need to be done before the move. The physical equipment move will require us to empty our equipment trailer and make a round trip from Bradenton, Fl. to New Bern, NC. and back. We have looked at many options on how to make this move. Doing it ourselves with Help on both ends is by far the cheapest route to take. Please pray, and if the Lord were to lay on your heart to help financially in this matter please do. Material prices change daily as does Diesel fuel prices. We are guessing that it will be somewhere close to \$5000 to have everything in place and fully operational here in Bradenton. This gives us the ability to have someone here at all times to meet any emergency fabrication needs that would arise. This equipment will be able to be used here for the everyday needs of the Il Villaggio Missionary Village. This also puts us just a few miles from a missionary aviation ministry in Wauchula, Fl.

in hopes of still doing some aircraft work. Everything we are, have and do belongs to the Lord. We will begin Monday the 4<sup>th</sup> of August making preparations here. There is much to be done. Please pray as we make these changes.
