Little is remembered of the unaccounted days of life.

I sat up and listened intently to a message on The Faith of Abraham, when I heard that if totaled, only about 25 years of Abrahams entire life were accounted for; A few verses of his call out of Ur, A few moments on his journey through Haran to Canaan. After, within several quiet years, Abraham is raising a family and Moses recounts Abraham’s place as father of the River Jumpers, the *ha-’ivri* or *Ha-brei* modern name Hebrew: *One who left his home and ‘crossed over’, searching for a city whose builder and maker is God.*

Twenty-Five years summed-up: where have you been? Where are you going? **Our** life has been full of such moments, after years of preparation you have a right to ask the same of us. Just now, as I write this update and summarize just one month of ministry, American life is combating a medically induced crisis which changed anything you were doing last month, and perhaps for generations. We understand the ramifications facing homes and businesses. Some of these decisions will ultimately be brought before churches and supporters. They are crossing over into uncharted areas and a real walk of faith is tested. Please be assured; from our vantage point our walk is the same as it was before this happened. We came to Peru on faith. God has provided and will continue to provide. We believe God will provide for you and your families

needs as well. Our prayer is for you to take care of your family spiritually, physically, and financially through this. As I wrote to one of my students, “I don’t know what the world is going to do, I don’t know what you are going to do. I am trusting God, as I always have and don’t worry about what He is going to do.” Even though our ministry is changed in its execution, it has not altered in its effectiveness. We have built solid relationships with our people for a purpose. They can confide in us their fears. They can witness our faithfulness to God. They have accepted food and money from our store. Many are listening to God’s Word through the teaching platform La Molina Christian Schools is using to continue classes from their homes. How many parents will hear the word! Look how God used Esther in Ch. 4 vs. 14

For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, then shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father’s house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for such a time as this?

We know we are here in Peru for such a time as this. Two days ago before the borders and airport closed, the US Embassy released any employee to return to the USA if they wished. We also are ambassadors of a holy kingdom and have decided to remain with our people here. We certainly need to be here as the country recovers. If a national revival is coming, we desire to be used !

MK camp at the end of January was more needful than we imagined for MK's (missionary children), in South America. We endeared ourselves to the children of missionary fathers and mothers. We're grateful for the Deighton family and Greenwood's work in South America we spent time with. It was our privilege to be with them in Nieve Nieve, the very same valley of Antioquia I am always telling you of! Rose Marie and I had the important assignments to disciple and counsel the youth that came to camp. MK's may sometimes feel like the "outsiders of the outsiders." It helps you to understand how much they need your prayer. A son of a missionary in Peru approached me after the service to talk. He was battling depression and anger against his parents for bringing him to the field as a teenager. He felt alone and doubted his salvation. As I listened, it became obvious his "salvation" doubts were genuinely substantiated. His "confession" as a child was an admission he was angry and disturbed. He lacked the saving confession that his sins made God angry every day. This young man was at best, concerned about his anger, not God's wrath. It stunned him that God's love did not pacify His anger. God's justice demanded payment as much as God's love demands mercy in the face of judgment. The residual effects of camp on my life, personally, is the reason I wanted to be a part of ministering to the next generation of missionaries for missions to continue.

You undoubtedly have many things to pray for, pray then.
