Step #3. As the articles start coming in Matt is already pumping out different layout designs and ideas. It's always exciting to see what he comes up with!

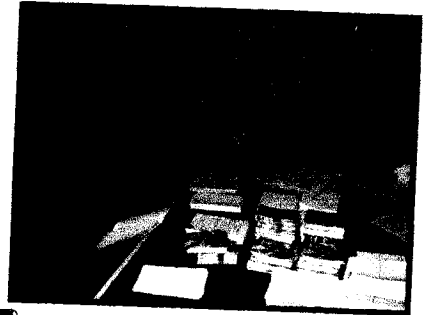


Step #5. The folding, collating, stapling, and trimming is done by several of us, including a few of our Spanish believers.
