I would like to thank you all for all the encouraging prayers, cards, and prayers that went up for my dad and the family during his bout with cancer. God saw fit to take him home to be with Him on March 6, 2012. Two days before his passing over God impressed upon me the verse Psalm 116:15, "Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his saints." As Christians we long for heaven: to see Jesus face to face, to see saved family and friends, to be free from this sinful flesh, to have no more sickness and pain, to see the mansions and streets of gold, etc... However, amazingly enough God also longs to see us as His children and precious in His sight is our homegoing. I am thankful for the testimony and legacy Dad has left us. His life is a challenge to me, to also be faithful to the end. There were some lost family and friends were at the funeral, and we ask that you continue to pray that through Dad's passing, souls would be saved.
