We had our last meeting with the disability lawyer on July 3rd, and then the court hearing is scheduled to take place on July 17th. Many have relayed recently that they are praying for us. We thank all of you for your support and prayers for us over these last months and would ask for you to please continue and be in special prayer for this upcoming hearing with Judge Marty Turner.

At my neurosurgeon appointment, the doctor told us that my condition was serious, but that he did not recommend surgery as an option for my condition. He said I had nerve damage that surgery could not correct and recommended that I pursue pain management as a more permanent solution. It is our prayer that this information will help our upcoming case.

Please continue to pray that it will work out for Christa to get the additional MRI that the radiologist recommended be done. After the MRI, she should be able to talk to her neurologist again and get on a set regimen of MS medications.

Thank you for your prayers for Christa's trip to Colorado. She and her parents had a safe trip and a nice visit. The church there was a blessing to her and she and her mama enjoyed the opportunity to speak to the ladies.

We wanted to especially thank those that gave toward our youngest son Kaleb's expenses while he works at Treasure Mountain Bible Camp in Marble, Colorado.
