She went on to say that she has some clients have been with her for three years and they still do not even have a hearing scheduled. We were able to see this portion of the process completed in just over a year. Praise the Lord for the power of the prayers of God's people. God not only answered, but answered in a spectacular way!

The next step in the process is to await paperwork in the mail which will inform us of whom we should talk to next and also the monthly amount of income we will receive. Our lawyer said that we should begin receiving income in around 60 days.

Christa's neurologist has recommended a new medication. This time the bloodwork shows that she is a eligible candidate. The doctor filed for a financial discount from the pharmaceutical company and we are waiting to receive approval. We ask for your prayers for the Lord's direction.

Kaleb should return from working at Treasure Mountain Bible Camp in Colorado, and Kyle should return from his missions internship in Japan in just a few days. We have heard previews of reports about their summer experiences and are looking forward to having a grand celebration with the whole family praising God and thanking Him for answering so many prayers.
