At just 13 days old he was transported to the hospital by ambulance for low oxygen levels. While at a pediatrician visit, it was discovered he was wheezing and bluish in color. Within a few hours we got the diagnosis of RSV. We then spent the next 6 days in the children's hospital so Judson could get the support he needed to overcome the virus. What a scary time!

At his follow up appointment, all his vitals were back to normal and he has begun gaining weight again!

Another praise: we have our return tickets! This season of furlough has been encouraging to us, but we are eager to return to the place to which God has called us. Lord willing, we will head back to Cambodia on March 26. All of the needed paperwork is already coming together in a timely manner, which is a great blessing. Please pray for the preparation and packing that must take place in this next month. Also, please pray that all the physical concerns will not take our energies away from the needed spiritual preparation. We know that any attempt to do the Lord's work will meet with opposition, and we desire to be ready to meet it and triumph in God's strength. At this point, our plan is to move immediately to the town of Memot (pronounced may-mut - rhymes with "put"), located about 2 hours east of our previous ministry location. To our knowledge, there is no church in this town, and our desire is to preach the Gospel and see a church established there. Here are a few specific requests for this move:

1. A suitable place to live in Memot - preferably a house with some "Western-style" amenities, in close proximity to many neighbors with whom we can build relationships.
2. Good initial contacts with key people in the town who can, in the providence of God, do much to help or hinder the work.
3. Wisdom and vision for important decision-making. Choices we make in the first days of our time may well set the tone and direction for our ministry in Memot. We want to be led of the Lord.
