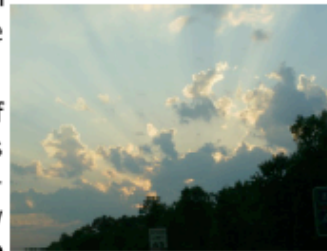
- We need wisdom about when to begin full-time deputation.
