We have seen many answers to prayer: we are seeing more of the children coming back, Lazarus has started to come here and there, and new visitors. This week, we have a meeting with Lazarus and his wife. We are asking you to pray that we can get these two and the rest of their family back into church.

As a child, my family and I were missionaries in the Marshall Islands. A man from the church would take my dad's messages and repeat them to his family members throughout the week. One of the men in the church, Albert, began doing the same here. All of his extended family was meeting and soon they were all arguing. Albert stood up and began repeating my message from Sunday. Praise the Lord! They were all quiet and listened to what he and the Bible had to say. We have seen much growth in his life since we have been gone, and he has started the discipleship program with a couple. Please pray that he continues to stay close to the Lord and continues to grow!

Lawson is the son of the man who built our building and started a church years ago. Lawson has graduated Bible college and at one time preached the Bible in Kosrae.
