Dear Pastors & Praying Friends,

First of all, I would like to thank you for your continued prayers. We have seen some answers to prayer and want to praise the Lord for His blessings. We were told not to expect the girls' passports renewals until after the first of the year at the very earliest. Not very long after our last prayer letter went out, we received them both in the mail. Covid may have slowed our government down, but our God is greater, and it is always good to remember that!

Our ministry continues in our absence! This is another answer to prayer. I am thankful we have some mature believers who are able to help the younger believers at this time. Right now, Tafunsak is only meeting in person on Sunday morning. Our Sunday School teachers are still seeing a good number of children, but the adults have thinned a little. I am still posting a Sunday and Wednesday night service from here, but I can't wait to be back in person. It is a strange thing to preach a message to a computer screen.

Second, there are some continued prayer requests. The Federated States of Micronesia is still closed to inbound travelers. The Marshall Islands did a test run to return people, but it included five weeks of quarantine and several Covid tests. There was going to be a test run for our islands on December 5th, but as of December 1st, the FSM Government indefinitely postponed this flight. This would have been the first inbound flight since March. Congress has extended the ban of all FSM inbound travel to January 31st. Pray for us as we face the unknown!

Another prayer request is for Megan's health. We were told that she was exercising too much. When is the last time a doctor told you to eat more salt and exercise less? But what we are learning is that repetition is best. The week of Thanksgiving was really hard on her health, but we were able to work through the issues and continue to ask God for healing.

The girls have been busy in their school, and we have enjoyed the preaching and fellowship at our home church. I am also thankful that Pastor Beilfuss keeps me busy with a couple of projects around the church. Not knowing when Kosrae will be opening back up, we are available to update some of our supporting churches. I have tried to reach out to most of the churches we missed on our 2018 furlough but have only taken three meetings this year.
