Understandably there have been some meetings that we had to cancel because of Norma being in the Hospital. I praise the Lord for those that understood my situation, when I had to cancel. Each Church and Pastor said, “Brother Heath, your first responsibility, at this time, is your wife.” Norma has been a real servant of our Lord and I appreciate every one of you that have called, written, or talked to us personally of your concerns and love for her. She sends her love and gratitude for your kindness, and affection, and prayers, for her.

Continue to prayer for Norma. Pray for the remaining meetings in this year. We are booked up with weekend meetings from now through the middle of December. Pray for the completion of the Church building in Guam.
