At the present, we are helping a dear brother with his small church in Trenton, NC. Brother Jerry Gurganus had neck surgery and was not yet able to preach. Every Sunday in October was full. On Oct. 11th, I preached in Harker's Island in the morning and preached on Skype to Grace Baptist Church at Hilo, Hawaii at 5:00 p.m. So, with the opportunities that the Lord is giving us to present the "Good Tidings," Please keep us before the Throne of Grace.
