Dear Co-laborers in Christ,

*"If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food, And one of you say unto them, Depart in peace, be ye warmed and filled; notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit?" James 2:15 & 16*

It was so exciting to be part of the Haitian Relief effort during the last week of January and into the first couple of days in February. We saw the hand of GOD in meeting needs, and taking care of us as we flew in support of the relief effort in Haiti following the massive earthquake near Port-a-Prince on January 12th. Our mission was to supply food and medical supplies to the Haitian people, in particular Christian Haitians and orphanages.

Bro. Seth Canady and I flew our Cessna 206 to Miami... coordinated with Operation Renewed Hope, loaded food for Haiti, and flew to Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic. It is located in the eastern two-thirds of the island shared with Haiti. Pallets of food were waiting for us there. Bro. Seth did a great job of coordinating the preparation and loading of the aircraft in Santo Domingo for each trip westward into Haiti.

This was a tiring 12 days of flying, loading, and unloading aircraft, but oh so rewarding. With the roads out, there was no other way to reach the cut-off people on the south and southwest side of Port-a-Prince. It was so sad to observe food and water sitting on the pallets at the international airport in Port-a-Prince... yes, sitting... not getting out to the people except as a small trickle. The UN could not come up with a "good distribution plan". We moved some 13 tons of food, and medical supplies as well with four small general aviation airplanes to the smaller runways at Jacmel and Les Cays. With the roads covered in many places with boulders and rockslides, the only effective, safe travel to be accomplished was by air. There was no doubt to the effectiveness of small aircraft... mostly missionary aircraft... in reaching the Haitian people with food and medical help! Now the roads are beginning to be cleared and passable. Shelter is now the greatest need, with food a close second. The LORD put together a good team, and greatly used us to make a difference.

Please pray much for the people of Haiti... we are asking the LORD to cause a great spiritual awakening in that dark land! People are being saved, and the people are very thankful for the out-pouring of help. The Mayor of Jacmel made the decision to cancel the annual Mardi Gras Carnival, a very Satanic holiday with a Gospel Crusade. That became a reality with the help of Frank Garlock, Majesty Music, and others on Monday night, February 15<sup>th</sup>. That night there were 2500 in attendance, and on Tuesday night some 4000. Some 40 were saved the first night, results not known at this writing concerning Tuesday.
