What a large undertaking for us to replace two of our destroyed Quonset hangers here at Canaan Airbase, and yet it was a small thing for the Lord! We just could not see how, but we believed that it was time to trust that God would do what seemed "out of sight" to us. I saw a neat quote on a plaque that read "Faith is seeing in your heart what you cannot see with your eyes". We had to muster all of our faith; try to check our unbelief, and make the need known. We just had to leave the choice with Him, and see what He could do in the hearts of His people. Our precious Lord has shown His mighty arm again to us and this ministry. In our last prayer letter we said that we were anticipating the blessings and answers, and looking forward to sharing the good news when the answer came! It is all of Grace and we are so thrilled to report that all the funds have now come in! Thank you so much for your prayers, your gifts, and your encouragement ... you all had a big part in this! Wow, praise the Lord with us! The concrete footings and floors are now in place, and we have installed the connectors that will secure the hangars to the concrete. That was quite a bit of work drilling the required 184 holes in that concrete for the anchor bolts. Another big blessing is that two missionaries with metal building experience are coming the first week in June to help with assembling all that sheet metal to become two Quonset hangers!

> Other news and blessings: The aircraft inspections are finished, and I did go out to Chattanooga to check out Dr. Jeremy Benbrooks, missionary to Togo, West Africa in a new type of aircraft so that he would meet insurance requirements. He is flying it until his departure soon for Togo. Bro Seth Canady completed yet another milestone here when he received his Commercial Pilots License at the end of March. He has been helping on the hangar project with the bolt-hole drilling, and his oldest daughter Liberty has helped to drive in the bolts.
