

Dear Praying Friends:

Our hearts are thrilled to report to you of God's goodness in our ministry. Little did I realize when the Tsunami struck Asia in December that it would become the emphasis of our ministry in January and February. God opened a door of opportunity in the week after the Tsunami with one of our missionaries whose ministry area was affected in a serious way.

Nearly 300,000 people went into eternity, 17,000 of them in our missionary's country, India. Our missionary quickly mobilized an effort that would meet both the short and long term outreach needs. We began to let the need be known here and over \$30,000.00 has been given to help them provide the short and long term needs of people in the fishing villages which were so devastated. I visited the region to check on the progress and be involved in the distribution of supplies and repairs. While there I met a Hindu witchdoctor who was saved when he came to a free medical clinic we established for treatment. I met those who had lost family members and who had survived. Please pray for these believers.



I have seen God work in the first two months of the year with over \$200,000.00 committed to missions. I praise the Lord for how He still blesses each week in Missions Conferences as people step out on faith and give. We also rejoice in those who surrendered for full time service and for the one who was saved in February.
