Dear Friends,

September/October 2019

I apologize for the delay in this newsletter. We have been extremely busy but blessed to have missionary visitors from the US. Missionaries Don & Karen Clarke, also with WWNTBM, spent almost two weeks with us as they sought God’s direction regarding serving in Liberia.

The rainy season is coming to an end, *sort of*. This will allow the work at Faith Baptist Church to continue and the need for a church building to grow. We are so grateful to those who contributed to the purchase of the one-acre property last year, and we now need to raise approximately \$65,000 to construct a church building. Please be in prayer with us and also consider contributing to this need.

We cannot show enough appreciation to the individuals and churches who give special gifts throughout the year that allow us to purchase and provide ministry tools for so many churches. Because of these financial gifts, we have been able to help several churches with roof repairs and shelters for children’s ministries. They have also enabled us to continually provide large-print Bibles (*more than 250 given away*), print “little Bibles” (Bible verses) for children (*more than 1200*), print songbooks (*presently 800*) with soundtrack flash drives, whiteboards and markers, Sunday School teaching materials, and for workshop classes where they use poster boards to make song and Bible verse visuals. Our ministry was blessed to be chosen as missionaries by a New York church’s VBS this summer. That gift has allowed Brenda to purchase a laminating machine and several laminating sheets. This has been a tremendous help in laminating the visuals they are making during her workshops.

I am humbled by the numerous opportunities to teach Leadership Seminars, as well as preaching in conferences and Sunday services. Pray that God will use me as churches are seeking Biblical direction in many areas of ministry and life in general.

I have had the privilege of working with the leadership of the long-established Jake Memorial Baptist College and the Liberian Ministry of Education this past year as they are seeking to go from offering an associate degree to a full bachelor’s degree status. While it has been very time consuming, it has also been very rewarding. The numerous forms and documents have been presented, and we would appreciate your prayers that this new status will be granted. This will be a great benefit to our Bible College students as well as bringing Jake Memorial Baptist College into the forefront as a legitimate Biblical educational institution in the country of Liberia.

We are at that point where we must take a long-term furlough to report to many of our supporting churches. Therefore, we are praying and seeking for a missionary couple to come to stay in our home and fill the gaps in our ministries here while we are away. Please pray for us and with us regarding this issue.
